OWB v3 is available on linux libc and ucLibc for x86, ARM, SH processors.

Actually, OWB is integrated on several software platforms, including the AmigaOS.

A beta version is available righ now for premium members. A public release will be available in September on Pleyo's open-source web Platform : [www.sand-labs.org](http://www.sand-labs.org).
